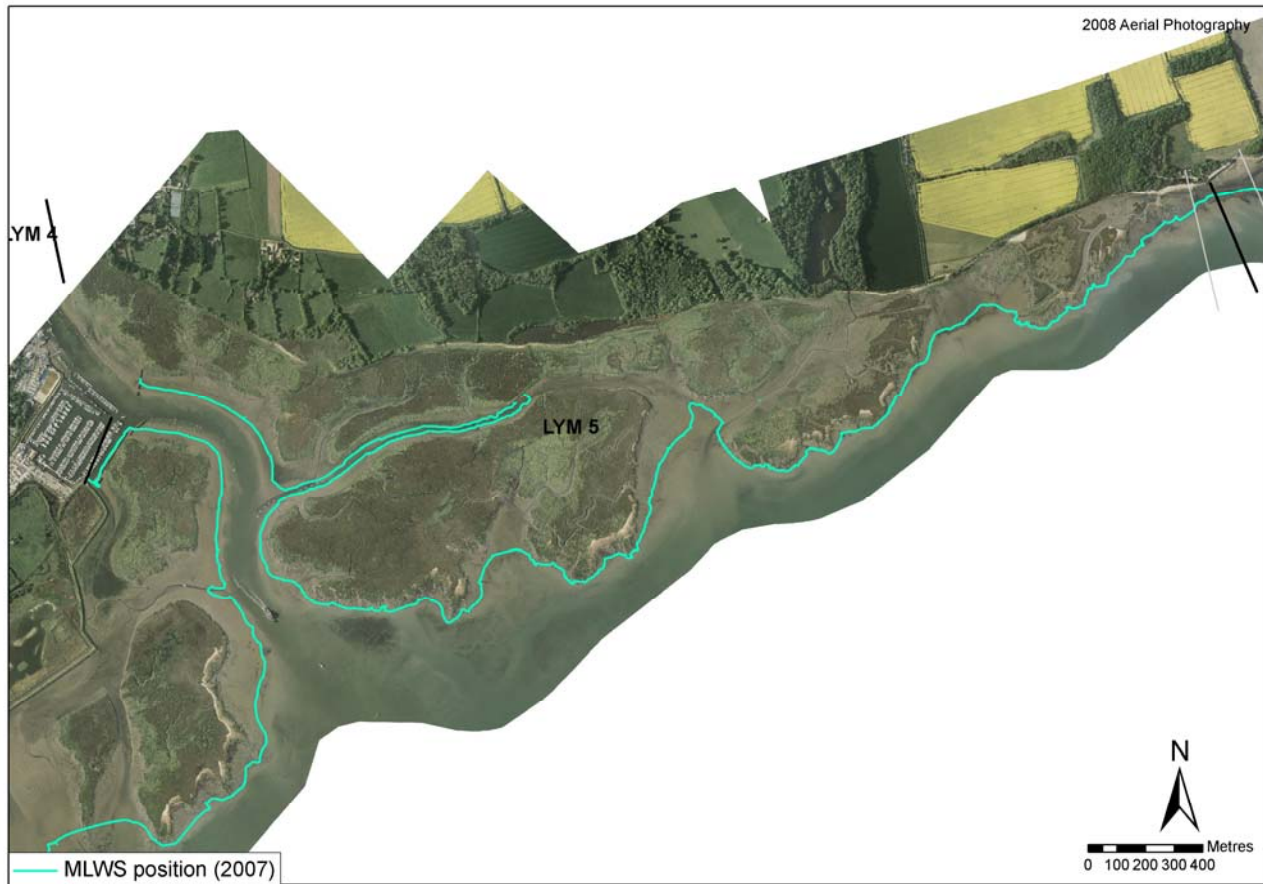

Summary

The majority of shoreline comprises saltmarsh and mudflat habitat. The saltmarshes are backed by a natural embankment. At the eastern end of the unit, the saltmarsh recedes to a narrow shingle beach fronted by gravels and muds around Pitts Deep, where there is a small seawall and revetment.
