

Policy Unit: 5f PHB3

Browsea Island (Undefended Western Section)



Summary

This policy unit covers the western end of Browsea Island, the largest island within Poole Harbour. The remainder of the island is covered by policy unit PHB2. Much of the island is surrounded by steep sloped cliffs which are vegetated on the north side and more vulnerable to erosion on the south side of the island. Sediment transport is thought to be from west to east around the island.
