South Haven Point to Hyde's Quay



Summary

This management unit covers the majority of the southern side of Poole Harbour, stretching westwards from the tip of the Studland Peninsula to the eastern edge of the Arne Peninsula. It is largely composed of natural mudflats, saltmarsh, tidal inlets, sandy beaches and a vegetated shoreline.

The harbour is an area of national and international importance for wildlife conservation, with the open water, mudflats, marshes and reedbeds providing valuable habitats. The area holds a number of statutory designations which serve to protect the natural environment.
